



Dutch Total Soccer Inclement Weather Policy
Soccer Camps
Summer 2015

Dutch Total Soccer (DTS) offers multiple soccer programs over the summer season that can be impacted by inclement weather (forecasts) or field conditions. DTS will always put the safety of players first and strives to make accurate calls on the camp sessions if the weather conditions or forecasts require so.

Session Cancellations

Obviously we would rather not cancel a camp session. However, as player safety is top priority the weather or field conditions might force us to cancel (part of) a camp session. If (part of) a camp session gets cancelled parents will receive an email shortly after the call is made. The director on site will carry emergency phone numbers at all times to reach out to parents in case they do not get the email in a timely manner.

Make ups / Credits

Below is the make-up/credit policy when camp sessions are cancelled due to inclement weather or field conditions:

- 1 Day Cancellation** (Half Day/Full Day depending on the camp) cancellation will not be made up.
- 2 Day Cancellation** (Half Day/Full Day depending on the camp) cancellation will be tried to make up by extending/adding a session (if not possible, then players receive a credit for other activities)
- 3 Day Cancellation** (Half Day/Full Day depending on the camp) cancellation will be credited pro-rated for other activities.

Extreme heat

Camps will generally not be cancelled due to heat conditions. However, high temperatures will warrant for extra water breaks during the sessions. It is strongly recommended to bring plenty of (iced) water and wet towels to cool down during these breaks.
